OUR COMPUTER

The same instant that I touched the "t" tab on this computer's keyboard, a "t" was printed to begin this sentence. Actually, it wasn't the same instant, because the keyboard had to send a electric impulse to the computer which has been programmed to type a "t".

Another electrical impulse was also sent before the "t" was typed. My brain sent an impulse to my arm muscles which in turn contracted the ligaments which forced my finger to come down on the "t" tab. In essence, my brain is set up and functions very much like the computer. In fact, there is very little electrical difference between my brain waves and the electrical "wave" which is sent by the computer.

I like to compare this programming to the clock of this computer I am using. Whether this computer is turned on or off, the clock keeps seemingly perfect time.
